## DIVISION II: FLORAL DESIGN

### *“Showcasing the Drama of Lilies in Floral Design”*

Class 1: Rhode Island: The America’s Cup. A parallel design

Class 2: New Hampshire: The Granite State. A creative line-mass design

Class 3: Maine: An austere landscape. Mono-botanic design: plants & plant parts

Class 4: Connecticut: from the Native American Quinetucket “beside the long tidal river” A low profile design

Class 5: Massachusetts: One if by Land and Two if by Sea. A reflective design

Class 6: Vermont: Moonlight in Vermont. Freedom of Style. Out of state exhibitors only (limit 4). Containers and plant material will be provided by the Committee.

### **Design Rules and Information**

- 1) There will be four (4) entries per class. One entry per class per person.

- 3) All designs must be in place by 9:30 am Friday July 12, 2019 and must be removed by 4 pm Sunday, July 14, 2019. Exhibitor must maintain designs in show condition throughout the show.

- 4) Plant materials must be listed with designer's name by Friday, July 12 at 0930.
- 5) Exhibit space may not exceed 24" wide & deep. No height limit.
- 6) Fresh and dried material may be used. A true lily or lilies (genus liliun) must be featured in all designs. Accessories or features may be used.
- 7) No artificial flowers or foliage may be used, or any plants on any state's Noxious/Invasive plant list. Endangered species may be used if grown in exhibitor's garden.
- 8) Standard system of awards will be used. NGC judges will judge using NGC rules. Judges' decision is final.
- 9) All properties should be labeled. NALS, any regional society and the Arnold Arboretum are not responsible for loss, damage or theft.
